We encourage you to be actively involved in our programs.

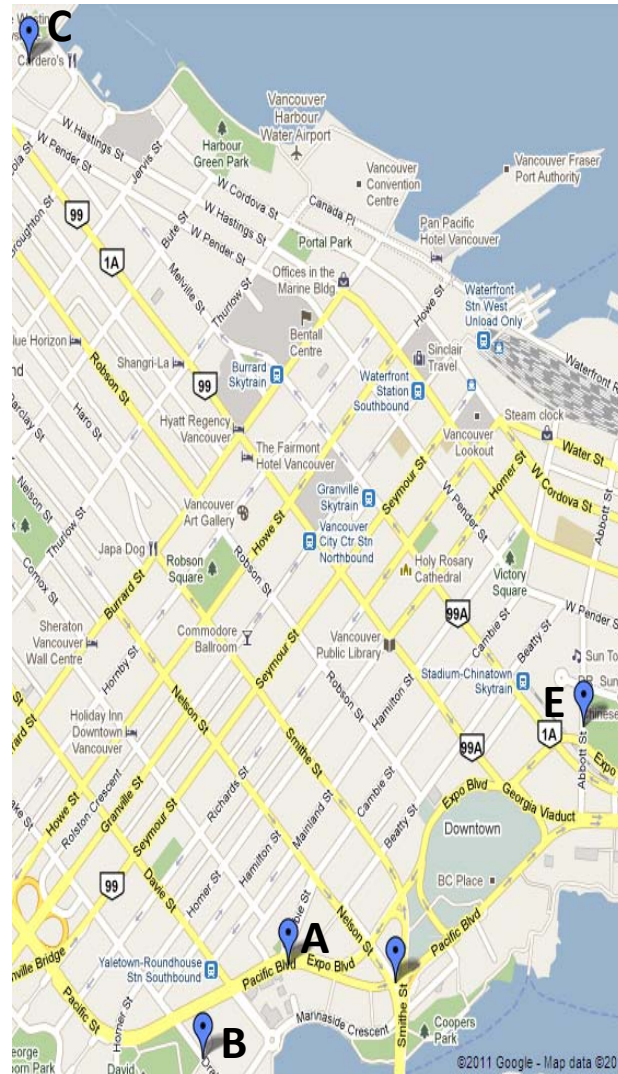
